## **Gearing up for education at Kennywood**

**West Mifflin, PA — Kennywood Education Days brochures are currently in the mail to thousands of teachers in the tri-state area for use in planning an “educational day” at the park.** The twelve thousand students expected to participate on one of two days at Kennywood (May 6 or 24, 2005) can only do so with plenty of advance preparation by teachers. From classroom readiness to chartering buses to registration forms and collecting money, this is a sizeable undertaking.

This year both dates include **Physics, Mathematics @ Kennywood, Math & Science Passport**, the *Pittsburgh History & Landmarks Foundation’s Architecture* Program, and *Phipps Conservatory’s* worksheets entitled **Plants at Kennywood**.

Friday, May 6 also offers the *Point Park University Communication* program, **Ham Radio** with operators from *Belle Vernon High School*. Tuesday, May 24 includes extra **Science & Math** programs, including the **NASA demonstration** and *Carnegie Science Center’s Sound Off*.

For the second year, Point Park University & Kennywood will offer a teacher workshop for Act 48 credit.
